

# Entry Requirements

## **Academic Programmes**

### Subject specific requirements for:

- □ Biomedical Sciences (academic backgrounds in Biosciences, Pharmacy, Nursing, Public Health will be considered)
- ☐ Mathematical Finance (prerequisites of calculus, probability and statistics, or have the equivalent level of knowledge)
- ☐ Global Environmental Issues (subject backgrounds in environmental science, environmental engineering, public health, biosciences or other related topics)

## **English Language Requirements**

- □ CET 4 at grade 530, CET 6 at grade 500.
- □ IELTS 6.0 overall with no lower than 5.5 in any band.
- TOEFL IBT 80 overall with no less than 19 in listening, 19 in reading, 21 in speaking and 19 in writing.
- □ PEARSON with a minimum of 53 in listening, reading, writing and speaking.
