## Japanese Language Lessons

You will acquire the linguistic and cultural knowledge needed for getting around Japan and carrying out casual conversation with native Japanese speakers.

Session with Buddies	Yukiko Shimmi	In this session, TUJP students will participate in collaborative learning and exchange activities with Tohoku University students who are assisting TUJP students as "Buddies" who are available during this time slot. Students will deepen their understanding of the Japanese language and culture while making friends. The student staff in charge of the International Student Help Desk will assist with the planning and running of this session.
TU student Office Hour	Student staff members	(Optional Support Opportunities) If the students have any questions on their studies for TUJP, student staff members from the International Student Help Desk staff are here to help TUJP students. The participants can request help on homework for their classes or ask any other questions. Please feel free to drop in. No appointment is required. If they do not have any questions, they do not have to come to the session.
Sparrow Dance Experience	Yukiko Shimmi	The Sparrow Dance (Suzume Odori) is a traditional Sendai dance that was first performed in 1623. These days, it is publicly performed and widely seen at the Sendai Asaba Festival, which is held in mid-May every year. In this session, the student will learn about Suzume Odori's history and structure, then practice it with TUJ students who participated in the Sendai Asaba Festival.
Aobayama Campus Tour by AA	IGC staff members	Student staff from Tohoku University's Aobayama Campus, Aobayama Campus will give a tour of Tohoku University's Aobayama Campus, Aobayama Campus with the largest of Tohoku University's four campuses. We will tour University House Aobayama (AHA), our resident student housing complex, which opened in 2017.
Loop Bus Tour	Gozan	The community volunteer group in Sendai called "Gozan" will take the students on the city tour using the loop bus called "Loop Sendai." The tour will start from the Sendai station near the stained glass and go to several sightseeing spots in Sendai City.
Visit to Student Club activities	TU students	In this session, participants will visit club activities at Tohoku University and hear about them from club members. Through observing club activities related to Japanese culture by Tohoku University students of the same profession, participants will deepen their understanding of multiple cultures.

Course Description (4 Weeks)

## Credits Awarded 取得単位

On completing the program successfully, students should be eligible to earn 3 ECTS \*(TUJP 2-week programs), 6 ECTS \*(TUJP 4-week programs) equivalent.

プログラムを修了すると、3ECTS \*(TUJP 2週間プログラム)、6ECTS \*(TUJP 4週間プログラム)相当の取得資格が与えられます。

\* 1 ECTS is equivalent to 25 hours of work. These credits are not conferred at Tohoku University, so each participant needs to request credits from their home institution with the certificate we issue.

\* Since TUJP puts an importance on real-time interactions, students are required to attend more than 85% of all the sessions held in real-time to pass the program. Please also see the FAQ about the handling of absences.
